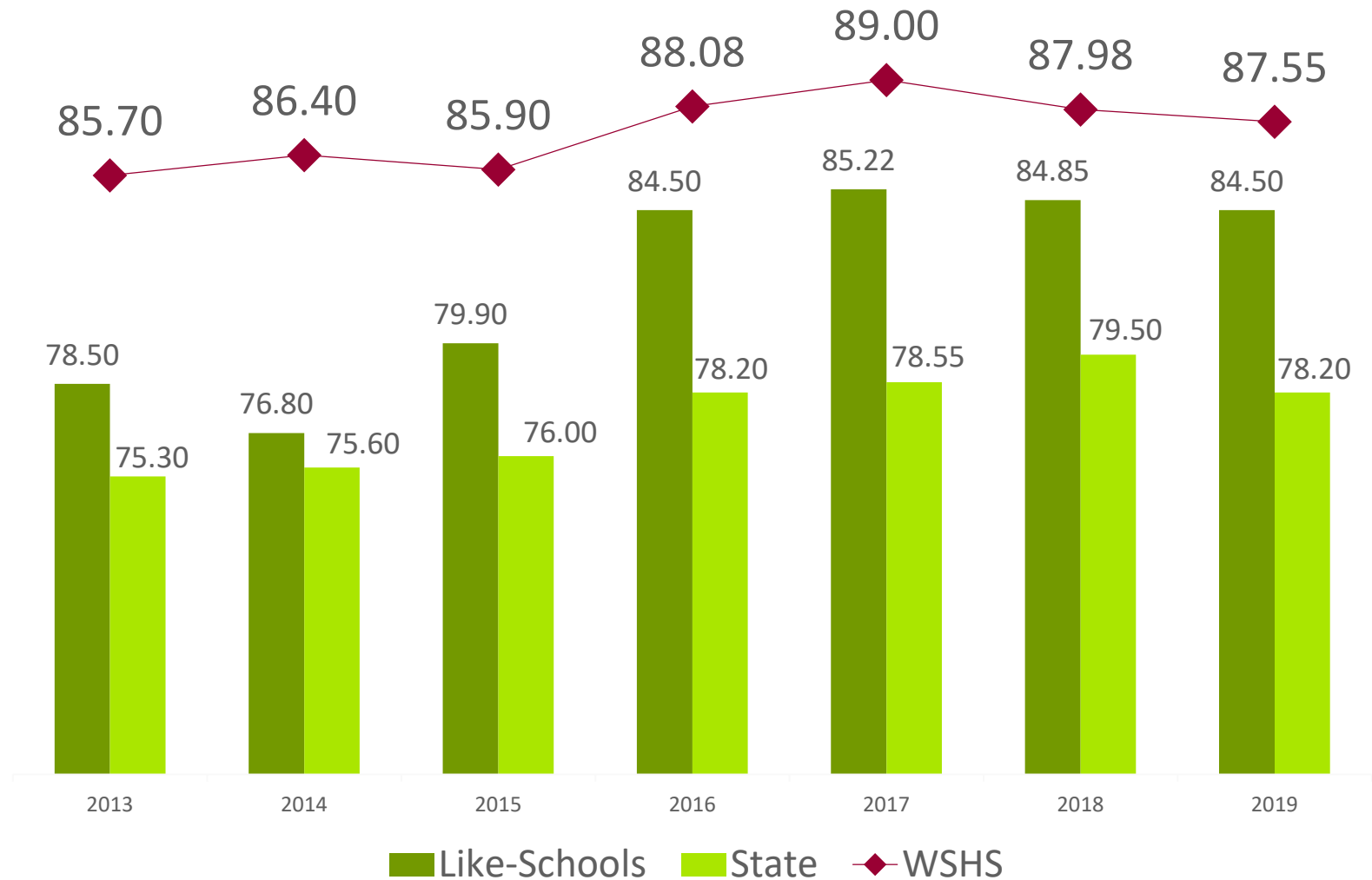

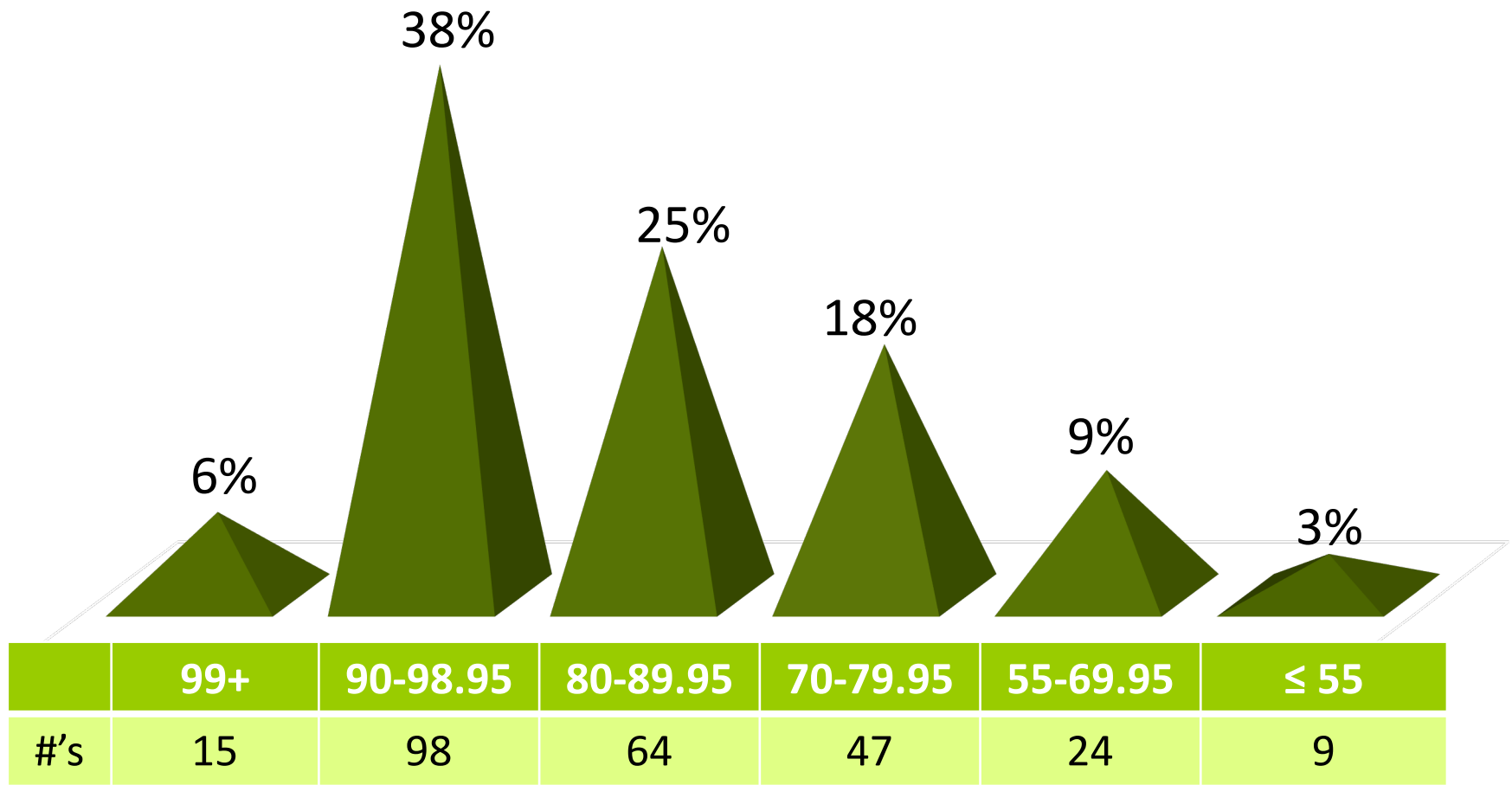

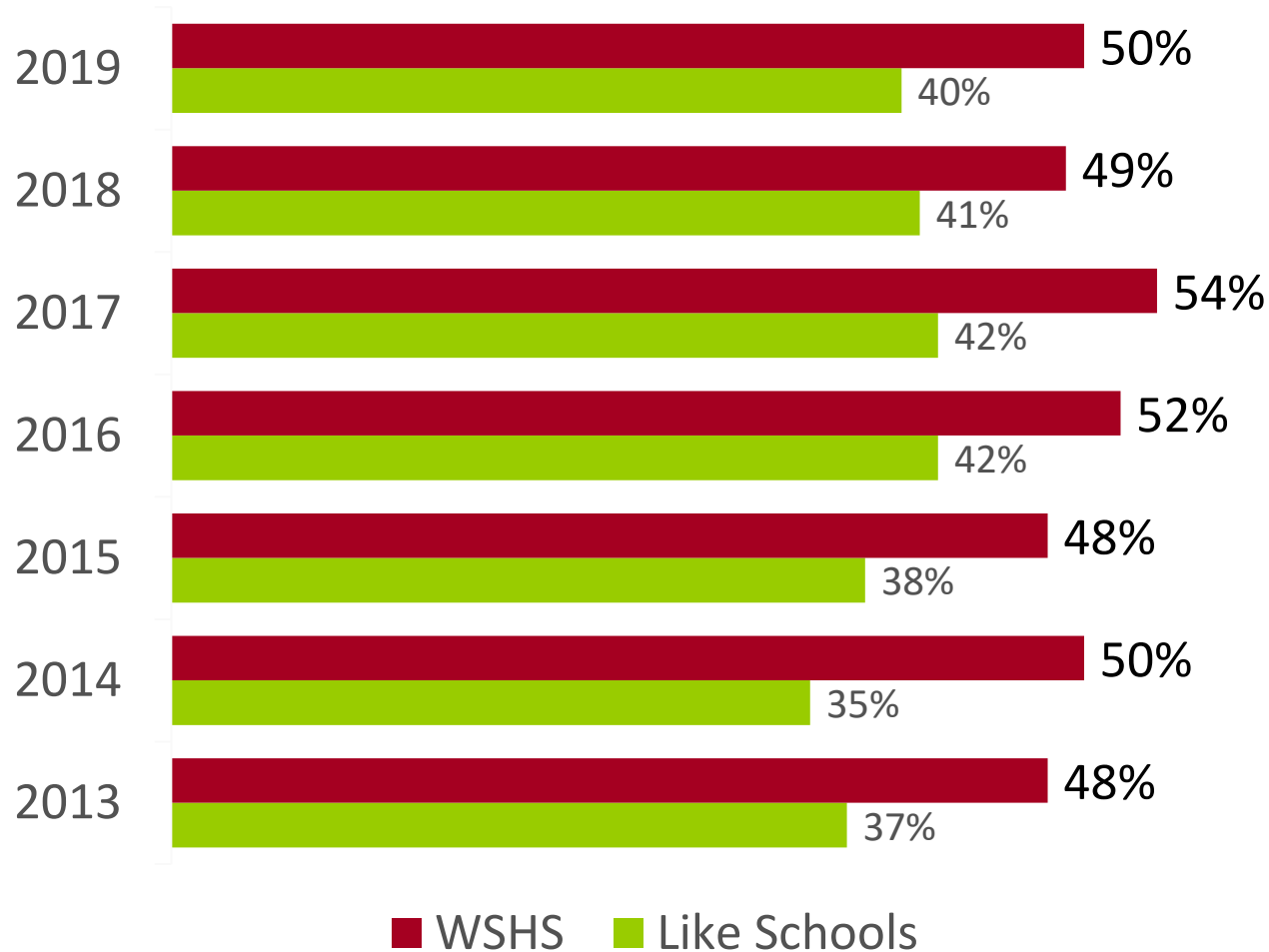
MEDIAN ATAR 2013-2019
